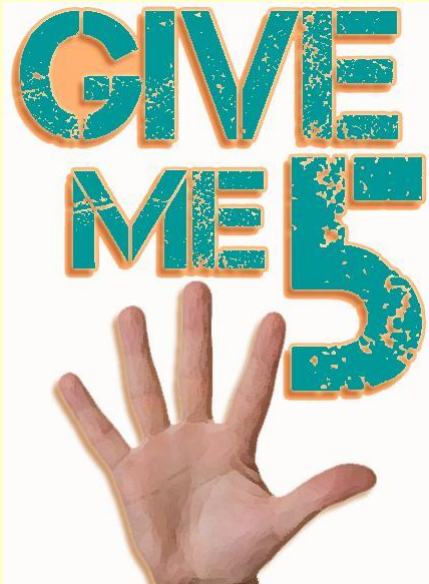

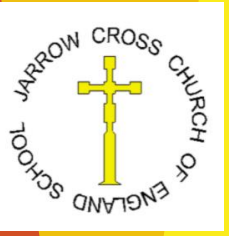


Source F - Written in the 16th Century by a close friend of Henry VIII.
