Dear Parent /Carer

Now that your child has settled in to their KS2 class, we feel this is a good time to clarify some of the more practical information as the second half of the autumn term begins.

One of the most important pieces of information is that children are continuing to read regularly, one-to-one with teachers and support staff, however you will have noticed that staff will not have been writing in Reading Records. This is due to our current health and safety protocols. Staff will continue to ask pupils to show them their records to monitor home reading.

We are expecting pupils to read at least three times per week and write a sentence in their record commenting on what they have read each time. Alternatively, parents can still comment on behalf of their children. Children who don't complete the expected level of reading will make up this time on Friday afternoons in class. Similarly, pupils who do not complete their homework will have to complete this in class on Friday afternoons if it has not been handed in. Children should ask if they need help with homework and staff will be more than happy to assist them with any difficulties.
