

Pupil Premium 2018-19

As of September 2012 the government requires all schools to publicize how they spend their pupil premium.

Jarrow Cross receives a Pupil Premium Grant for each child who is currently entitled to receive Free School Meals or who has been entitled over the last five years, and also for any Looked After Children.

Funding has allowed us to provide additional support for children in school through the employment of additional support staff and teachers. This allows us to provide targeted intervention for all children who are not making the expected progress by reducing class and groups sizes and running specific intervention.

Jarrow Cross' Pupil Premium Grant for 2018-2019 is £151,800 At Jarrow Cross we will use this money to support the teaching and learning of our children and also to ensure that the social and emotional needs of our children are met.
