## Pupil Premium 2019-20

As of September 2012 the government requires all schools to publicize how they spend their pupil premium.

The pupil premium for 2019 to 2020 Jarrow Cross includes pupils recorded in the January 2019 school census who are known to have been eligible for FSM since May 2013, as well as those first known to be eligible at January 2019.

Funding has allowed us to provide additional support for children in school through the employment of additional support staff and teachers. This allows us to provide targeted intervention for all children who are not making the expected progress by reducing class and groups sizes and running specific intervention.

Jarrow Cross' Pupil Premium Grant for 2019-2020 is £159,580. At Jarrow Cross we will use this money to support the teaching and learning of our children and also to ensure that the social and emotional needs of our children are met.
