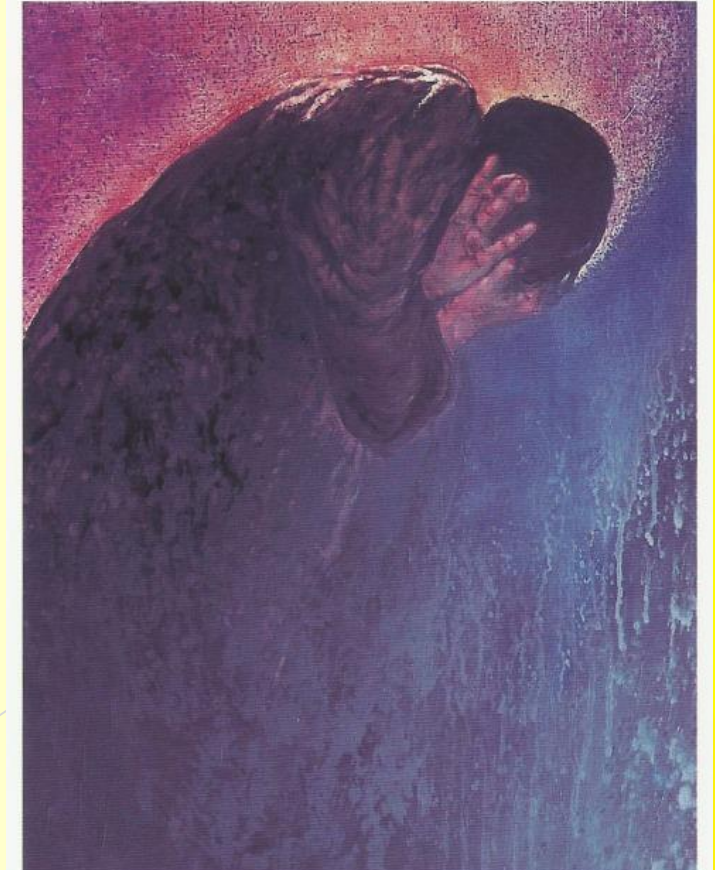
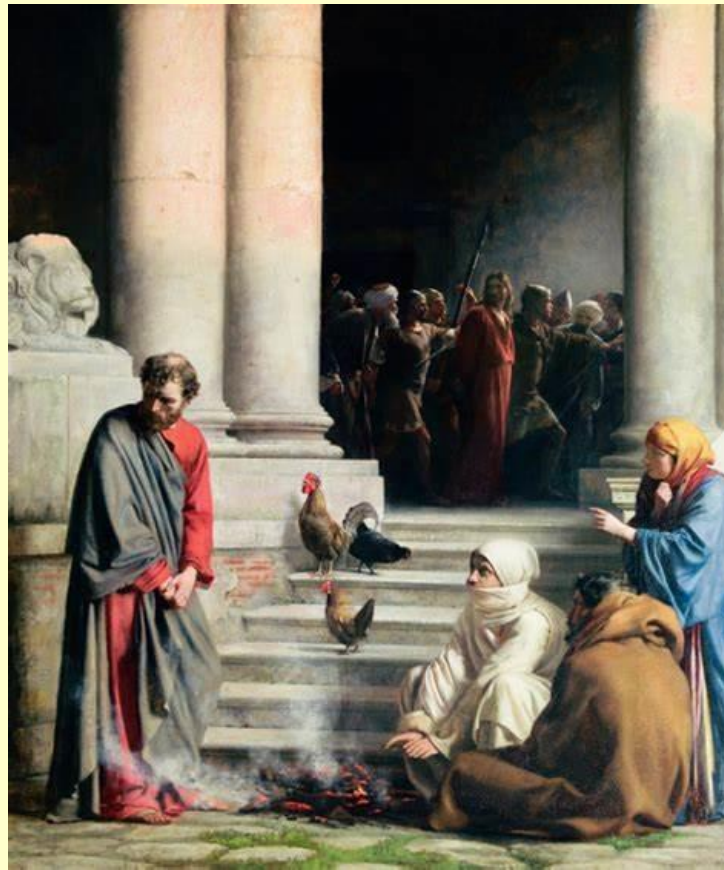
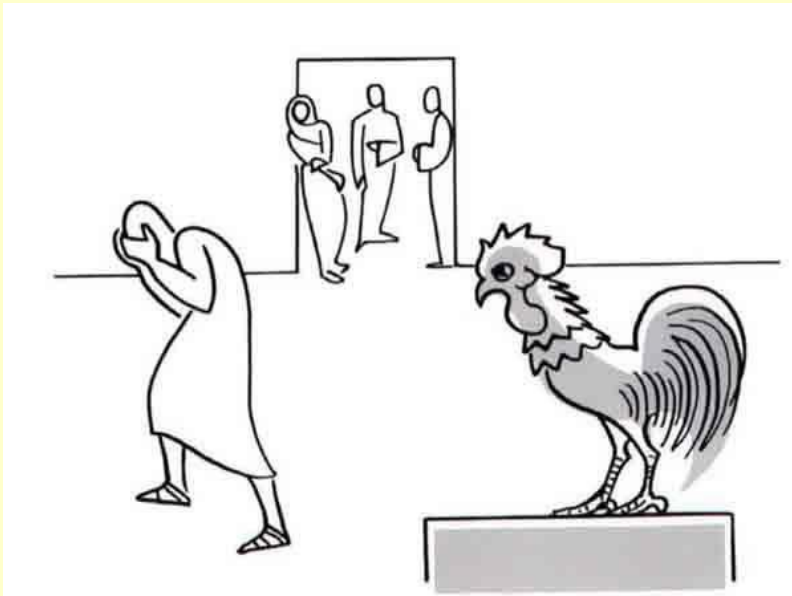
Jesus understood his death as a choice and part of God's big plan of salvation so how might his emotions differ to the disciples?
