In our history lessons we will:

over time.

In our science lessons we will:

Describe how animals grow and change and link this to the Seasonal changes of Winter. We will explore the properties of materials and carry out lots of classifications and experiments..

In our art lessons we will:

We are going to create a Winter scene, mixing paint to create lighter and darker shades of colours. We look at the work the work of Romero Britto and discuss pop art.



In technology we will:

We will make a toy from the past and in music we will explore changes in music such as loud/ soft, fast/ slow.

In our Literacy lessons we will:


Develop our phonic skills and our fluency and expression in reading.

We will begin to use prepositions in our sentences.



In our Numeracy lessons we will:

Learn to add and subtract numbers within 20 and use the correct vocabulary

We will learn the properties of 2D and 3D shapes.

We will learn how to use Mathematical equipment correctly to help us solve problems.

To learn 2, 5 and 10 times table
