This term in Year 3 our topic is called Attack Attack!

In our history lessons we will:

be studying the effect on society by Roman invaders. We will look at our local environment and how it was effected by the Roman Invasion. We will also study who was Queen Boudicca and the part she played during the Roman invasion of Britain.

In our science lessons we will:

look at materials which keep us warm and consider which materials make good insulators.

In our Geography lessons we will:

be studying the areas the invaders came from and why they wanted to invade Britain.

In our Technology lessons we will:

design a mosaic and shield in the style of the Romans and design a Roman chocolate road.



In our Literacy lessons we will:

We will be writing diaries as the Killer Cat (based on the novel by Anne Fine). We will also participate in drama activities, experiencing what life would have been like at the hands of the Romans. We will write our own diaries as Roman slaves and train at Gladiator school.

In our Numeracy lessons we will:

We will learn to read the time on a 12 and 24 hour clock (to the nearest minute). We will read timetables and calculate durations. We will also be learning how to recognise equivalent fractions,

Simplify fraction and add fractions. We will learn multiplication and division facts.

We will visit Arbeia Roman Fort and explore how Roman armies lived together in large communities. We will explore communities we have today such as schools, churches and other religious communities and discuss it means to be part of such communities.
