Out and About

This term in Year 3 we will be learning about the history of our local environment.

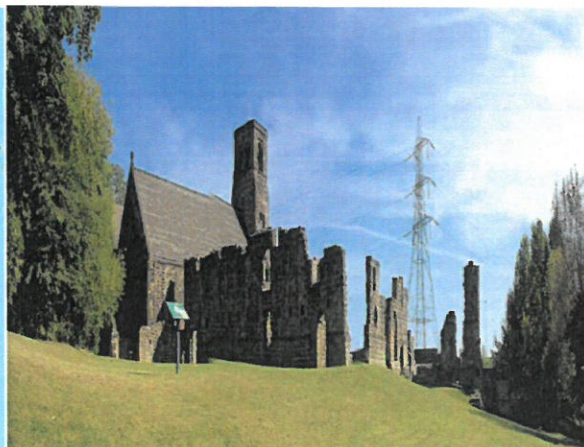
In our history lessons we will :look at how the area has changed since Anglo Saxon and Viking invasions and settlements and the impact the Vikings had upon Jarrow.

In our geography lessons: we will look at where and why the Anglo Saxons and Vikings arrived in England and their impact upon the British people.

In our science lessons we will : look at the rocks and plants of the local area and study different types of rocks and soils. We will also look at the characteristics of materials linked to Anglo Saxon settlements.

In our technology lessons we will: design and construct Viking ships and make food products to take on our travels.

As artists we will use a variety of tools to create illuminated letters, write in Runes and create stained glass windows.



In our Literacy lessons we will:

In literacy this term we will be learning about Myths and Legends (linked to Scandanavia). Through drama, we will explore the story of Peer Gynt (In the Hall of the Mountain King) and Beowulf to develop our own versions of this myth.

In our Numeracy lessons we will:

This term we will be learning to reflect and rotate shapes, plot co-ordinates as well as reading and finding angles of specific shapes. We will also learn problems solving techniques using all four operations.

Other activities

We will learn about the importance of The Lindisfarne Gospels and by whom and why they were created. We will also visit Bede's World and look at how the Anglo Saxon and then Viking Communities worked together and relied upon each other in every day life.
