Curriculum Topic

Its all Greek to me!

This term in Year 5 we will be learning about The Greeks.

In our history lessons we will: learn about Greek civilisation. We will consider who were the Ancient Greeks – their lifestyles, food, homes, clothing, wars, religion and gods. We will look at important events in Greek History and compare and contrast Greek life from the past to the present day.

In our Geography lessons we will: locate Greece on maps of the world and Europe and identify features of Greece's landscape.

In our science lessons we will: investigate sound and think about how sound is produced as well as how it travels. We will use music to investigate how pitch and volume can be changed.

By looking at Greek athletes, we will consider how to keep fit and healthy.

In our art lessons we will use a variety of techniques and materials to recreate Greek art.







In our Literacy lessons we will read Greek legends in different formats and discuss the features of myths, legends and fables as well as writing our own versions.

We will develop out own mythical characters and write stories including them.

We will also produce travel brochures persuading people to travel to Greece and produce a report about the life of the ancient Greeks.

In our Numeracy lessons we will be recognising and extending number sequences as well as investigating square and prime numbers. We will consolidate our knowledge and understanding of the four operations.

We will investigate shapes and their properties and identify different types of triangles.

We will look at fractions and percentages and solve problems relating to all areas of learning.

Other activities: We will consider the difference in the Ancient Greek societies of Athens and Sparta. We will also look at Greek menus and food and develop our own Greek banquet.
