Curriculum Topic

Disaster!

## This term in Year 6 we will be learning about disasters.

In our geography lessons we will : use our mapping skills to locate areas where natural disasters have occurred using grid references. We will investigate the impact of natural disasters on the economy and suggest how an area might change in the future.

In our science lessons we will :investigate the life cycle of all living things and study reproduction of some plants and animals .

While learning how sounds are made and can be changed, we will find out about how the human ear works.

In our history lessons we will: look at various source material to draw conclusions about Ancient Rome and specifically the eruption of Mount Vesuvius and the destruction of Pompeii

In our art lessons we will: use a range of materials to make representations of natural disasters.

In our Literacy lessons we will: write in the style of many different genres including newspaper articles, diaries and arguments. We will also read *Running Wild* by Michael Morpurgo and discuss the central theme of disasters.

In our Numeracy lessons we will: use directions and scale to solve maths problems, convert units of measurement and take part in investigations involving all four number calculations. We will be completing transition tasks in preparation for secondary school.

## Other Activities
